Thank you for your recent email regarding Copper, Chrome, Arsenic (CCA) treated posts.

South Australia's Strategic Plan seeks to reduce all waste to landfill by 25% by 2014 and through Zero Waste SA, the State Government has worked with industry, government and the community on strategies for waste avoidance, reduction, reuse and recycling.

Your "ocloc" product will contribute significantly in the reuse of CCA treated timber posts and I commend you for supplying a product to the market that will assist industry in reducing their costs.
